



Five Rivers of Pakistan

Description

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Mainly *five rivers* that pass mostly through the *Punjab province*; therefore the name '*Punjab*' — '*panj*' meaning *five* and '*aab*' meaning *water*. The five rivers of Pakistan are *Indus, Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi, and Sulej*. This information is very useful for tests and interviews

1. *Indus*

Indus river is the *longest river* in Pakistan, With a total length of *3,180 kilometres*. Indus River originates from the *Tibetan plateau* near *Lake Mansarovar*. *Tarbela Dam* is built on the *Indus river* opened in *1976*.

2. *Jhelum*

River Jhelum is nearly *774 kilometres* long and is the *tributary of River Chenab*. Jhelum originates from the south-eastern part of *Kashmir valley*. *Mangla dam* was constructed in *1967* is on river Jhelum.

3. *Chenab*

Chenab flows through *Jammu and Kashmir*. It is then joined by the Jhelum River at *Trimmu*. Chenab River is nearly *960 kilometres* long.

4. *Ravi*

River Ravi *originates in the Himalayas*. River Ravi is nearly *720 kilometres* long. It's also called '*The river of Lahore*' since the city of *Lahore* is located at *Ravi's eastern bank*.

5. *Sutlej*

Sutlej is located north of the *Vindhya Range*, south of the *HinduKush* segment of the *Himalayas*, and east of the *Central Sulaiman Range* in Pakistan. Some *550 kilometres* long, Sutlej is also called as the "*Red River*".
