In continuation with my earlier posts, I am going to discuss a very important paper, i.e. Current Affairs. This is the most important of all the papers since it helps you out in Current Affairs, Essay, International Relations, International Law, Pakistan Affairs, etc. Therefore, it needs to be given its due weight-age.

1) #Subject\_Analysis:

- i. Current Affairs (CA) as a subject is quite an easy one.
- ii. We all know what is happening all around us.
- iii. You simply need to be tactical in your approach and justification of your stance is highly crucial.

2) #Syllabus\_Analysis:

- i. The syllabus has been divided into 3 Major Areas:



- a. Domestic Affairs
- b. External Affairs
- c. Global Issues.

ii. All the domestic affairs of Pakistan such as political, economic along with social issues comprise the first part.

iii. Relations with neighbors, Muslim world, USA and other world powers, and regional as well as International organizations are the features of External Affairs of Pakistan.

iv. Global Issues constitute all the current as well as decades old global issues (Kashmir issue and Palestine issue).

v. At least 2 questions appear from all of the 3 areas but External Affairs and Global Issues are majorly focused.

### 3) #General\_Guidelines:

- i. Stay relevant, precise, and logical with your answers.
- ii. Try to theorize your answer, hence, an understanding of the history and politics is pertinent.
- iii. Examiner requires analysis. Therefore, ensure that you are able to justify your stance.

### 4) #External\_Affair\_Questions

How to critically analyze external affairs from different perspectives;

i. Study Relations through Maps; Practice making the following three maps or an ATLAS so as to memorize them;

- a. World Map
- b. South Asian Map
- c. Pakistan Map

When you have a clear picture of the above maps in your head, it will be easier for you to deal with current affairs related questions.

ii. Influence of Other Countries:

- a. We all know that all the countries have some influence and interest in every neighbor country due to inter-dependency.
- b. In relation based questions such as Pak-Afghan Relations, Afghanistan has an Indian, Chinese, Iranian, and Russian influence which directly affect the dynamics of Pak-Afghan Relations.
- c. Critical analyses of these relations can be discussed in the question.

iii. Analyses from Different Perspectives:

- a. Bilateral Relations include Strategic, Political, Economic, Cultural, and Social level interactions.
- b. All the more reason studying relations has become quite difficult as two countries interact with each other on different fronts.
- c. For instance, Pakistan-China Relations are usually studied on a strategic and an economic front.
- d. Whereas, Pak-US relations have been studied from political and economic perspectives.



#### 5) #Domestic\_and\_Global\_Issues Section:

i. Keep a check on the events of later half of the previous year and the start of the year in which exams are to be commenced.

ii. You have to be conceptual and analytical in your answers and not merely factual.

Q; what are perfect platforms to get maximum information of current affairs?

Q; 8 ways to study current affairs?  
8 simple ways to study current affairs;  
Don't miss any contemporary themes which make news regularly, such as, political crisis in middle east, tiger conservation programmes, schemes for women empowerment etc...  
Make topic wise notes in chronological order to review the past happenings and understand the differences easily. For example, chronological listing of all the missile testings will help you to understand, which missile belongs to which category or family without any confusion.  
Follow the news updates from important ministries and organizations such as ministry of external affairs, MOEF, Ministry of finance, RBI, United Nations etc....  
Don't read too many newspapers. Already there is a consensus that many questions appear from the Hindu, Indian express, Business standard and Economic times. Stick with any one or two(if u need business affairs) papers and study them consistently.  
Don't study international affairs without a world map. It doesn't mean that you don't know the positions of the countries but the reason is, studying international affairs with a world map in hand will help you to understand and analyze the related issues with neighbouring countries in a proper light. It will also help you to get the complete picture of political, geographical or societal problems faced by the people regionally.  
Don't mug up the important dates. Try to associate the date with some issue to remember. It is also important to remember the related organization or country.  
Keep following a reliable current affairs website or magazine to study any left out topics.  
Finally, solve the current affairs quiz, offered by some websites for free on daily or weekly basis.



## How\_to\_Start\_Preparation:

- i. Now, you have got the basic structure ready.
- ii. Make a separate register for CA.
- iii. Specify the 25-30 topics comprising relations as well as organizations.
- iv. Write down the historical background.  
e.g. If you are talking about Pak-India relation, you must have a clear and detailed overview of the history of Pak-India Relations.
- v. On daily basis, pick up a national and international newspaper/magazine and look out for any update on your relevant topic and you just need to add that under 'Recent Developments' section.
